10 A group of flamingos is called a flamboyance!



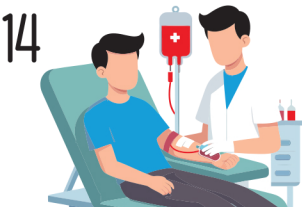
11 Honey never spoils. Archaeologists have found pots in ancient tombs containing honey that is still edible.

20 A crocodile cannot stick its tongue out!



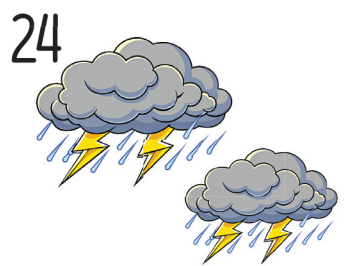
21 It's **International Yoga Day**. Did you know, there are more than 84 lakh yoga poses!

24 Lightning strikes Earth about 100 times every second.



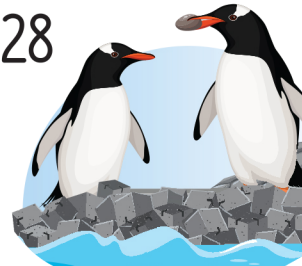
25 On this day in 1983, India won its first Cricket World Cup.



26 In Holland, you can be fined for not using a shopping basket at a grocery store!



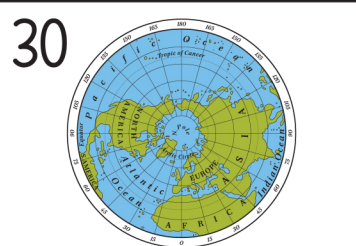
27 An olive tree can live up to 1,500 years.
