
It's International Day of Persons with Disabilities, a day that reminds us that everyone has unique abilities worth celebrating.

Elephants are known to celebrate victories—they trumpet loudly when happy!






Camels can drink up to 200 litres of water in just three minutes!

It's Christmas Day! Did you know, the tradition of decorating Christmas trees started in Germany over 400 years ago.




Poinsettias, native to Mexico, are called 'Christmas flowers' because their red leaves look like petals and bloom only in winter.
